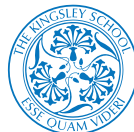

Welcome to your Enrichment Programme for the next term.

Sign up will be during form time on Monday 10th January. You will need your mobile phone, or you can log on to a computer in Room 16.

Please note:

- Only sign up to one club per day.
- Please check the schedules in your form room for days when you are already signed up to a club from last term, or expected to attend a club this term. Note these down in your booklet. Speak with the club teacher if you no longer wish to attend.
- If you have a clash of two or more clubs on any day, please speak to the teachers of each club to ensure you are registered to only one.
- Numbers for clubs are limited. If your first choice of club is full you will be put on the waiting list. You will then need to submit a second choice.
- For sports clubs, if for any reason you are unable to attend a particular session, your parents will need to e-mail sportsabsence@kingsleyschool.co.uk. Your name will then be added to the 'drop in' register for either a Monday or a Thursday and you will need to attend homework club in the LRC (Monday) or STEAM Room (Thursday).

DESCRIPTION:

The Additional Maths Free Standing Maths Qualification is a certificated course run by OCR. It is a bridge between GCSE and AS-level standards and challenges students aiming at the top grades. The course is very abstract in comparison to normal timetabled lessons and shows glimpses of new areas of maths that should help strengthen overall algebraic and logic skills.

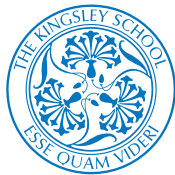
DESCRIPTION:
