Dear Parents,

I am writing to tell you about the Summer Papers (formerly known as Internal Examinations) which your daughter(s) will be taking in the week beginning Monday, 16 May. <u>A timetable is attached below for years 7-10</u>.

Most of these assessments will take place in classrooms. However, practical assessments, such as Food and Textiles, Information Technology, and Art, will take place in specialist classrooms. Additionally, most Year 10 students will sit their English and Maths assessments in the Gym. This is to give them some experience of what it will be like to sit their public examinations in June 2023.

During this week the whole timetable will be suspended. Every slot will then be taken up either with an assessment or with a supervised revision session. Students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will also have one games afternoon. All registers will be taken as normal, but there will be no enrichment activities.

For those students who are entitled to special arrangements when taking their public examinations, we will endeavour to support them as they attempt their Summer Papers in a way that closely reflects the experience they will have when taking public examinations. However, with the entire school taking assessments at the same time, we cannot replicate this experience exactly as it would require more rooms and invigilators than the school has available. If you would like more information about this, please contact the Exams Office or talk to Mrs Rogers, Assistant Head (Academic).

Results will be circulated via an exam results grade card and then followed up with a Parents' Consultation Evening for Year 7 and Year 9 or a Full Report for Year 8 and Year 10.

Please take the opportunity to emphasise to your daughter the significance of these assessments, which will help them to prepare for their public examinations in due course. Over the coming weeks, students should be setting aside some time each day to prepare carefully.
