
# EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PRE SCHOOL








### ARRIVING IN THE MORNING

When you come to school you will wait in the playground until the bell goes. Your teacher will be in the classroom from 8:00am if you wish to talk to her. A bell will go at 8:35am and you will line up with the rest of your class outside your classroom.



### READING AND HOMEWORK

In Pre School we follow a phonics programme called Jolly Phonics. Every day we learn letters, sounds and letter formation which helps build the foundation to becoming a fluent reader and writer. You will also have an opportunity to choose a Home School book, when you are ready.

Occasionally, fun activities to do with Mummy and Daddy will be sent home on a Friday. These experiential activities are completely optional to complete however, it can be great fun to share with the rest of your class what you have done at home.



# WHAT DO WE WEAR?









All uniform should have your name in them, including socks and shoes.

Spare: it is always good to have spare trousers/bottoms, pants and socks at school with you just in case!





### WHAT DO WE EAT?



Children should bring in their own healthy snack to enjoy at morning break time. Milk will be provided for Preschool and Reception classes. Children will need to bring a clear water bottle which they can refill in their classroom.

### **FOREST SCHOOL**
