


# INTRODUCTION


This booklet is for you and your family. It tells you all about the different things that happen at School. We hope that you enjoy looking through it, and look forward to seeing you soon when you start school.

In Reception you will have a lovely book to take home and read with your family every week.


At the Kingsley School we follow a phonics scheme called Jolly Phonics. Every day we learn new phonemes from letters to digraphs along with their letter formation. The children will be learning how to blend and segment in order to be a fluent reader and writer.

On a Monday, each child will be sent home a Jolly Phonics book to share with you. This will include; our sounds of the week, words we will be segmenting and tricky words. This is for you to know where your child is in their learning and to help reinforce this learning at home. For homework, the children can practise the sound, have a go at drawing anything using that sound and cut out any pictures from a magazine or print pictures.


