I look forward to teaching you in September,

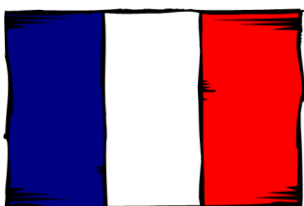
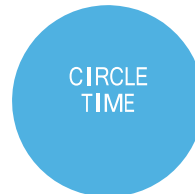
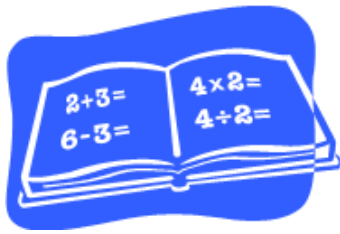

Can you try to match the pictures to the subjects inside the box?



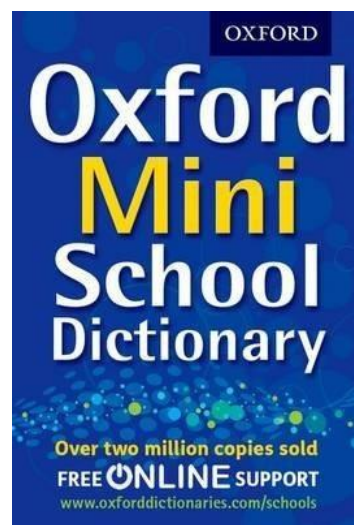
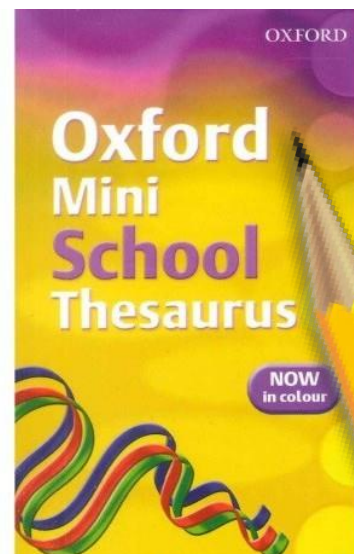

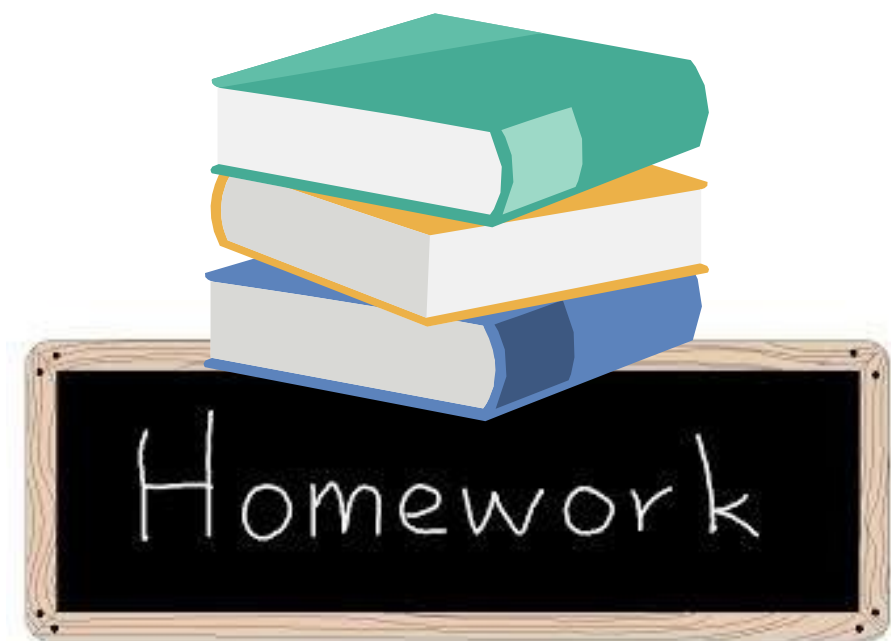


WHAT HOMEWORK IS SET IN YEAR 5?

You will be given a full homework timetable in September. Homework tasks are given in class and are also set on ClassDojo.

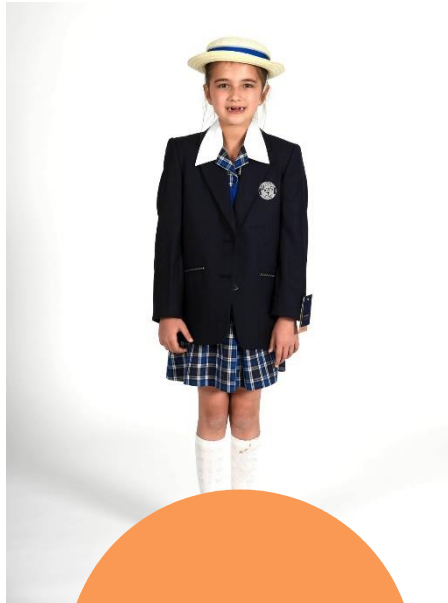
It is very important that you complete your homework to the best of your ability and it is handed in on time.

FOREST SCHOOL

One afternoon a week we spend time at Forest School. We learn about nature and use our senses to discover sights, smells, sounds and textures. We also learn about different types of knots; learn how to use tools to chop, saw and whittle; create fire balls and fire cups for tinder for our camp fire; and build dens, zip wires and different types of obstacle courses to challenge ourselves and others. These are just some of the amazing experiences we have!

You will need navy, long leggings or trousers, t-shirt and jumper. Black or navy waterproof jacket and bottoms. Wellingtons or walking boots, trainers for dry weather. These do not need to have the school logo on them. **In colder weather, please be prepared with hats and gloves.**
